

Nouns

- Able to identify common nouns as a person, place, or thing
- Able to identify proper nouns
- Able to identify and capitalize first and last name with teacher direction
- Able to identify and capitalize months of the year with teacher direction
- Able to identify and capitalize days of the week with teacher direction
- Able to identify and capitalize holidays with teacher direction

Verbs

- Able to recognize an action word that you can see
- Able to use simple tense – past, present, future –developed in oral language
- Able to identify and name verbs on a worksheet with teacher direction

Adjectives

- Able to recognize adjectives: color, shape, size, number
- Able to develop usage in oral language

Pronouns

- Able to capitalize “I” in writing
- Able to develop pronoun usage through oral language
- Able to replace noun with pronouns: he, she, we, they, it, we

Contractions

- Able to make contractions of: ‘ve, n’t, ‘re, ‘s

Compound Words

- Identify compound words from a given list
- Identify the two words that make a compound word.

Synonyms/Antonyms

- Identify synonyms from given list of words
- Identify antonyms from given list of words

Homonyms

- Identify which homophone to use in a sentence in a given word list
- Identify which homograph to use in a sentence from a given word list
