**NOUNS**

- Able to identify and use different forms of a noun, including common, proper, collective, abstract, concrete, and possessive
- Able to identify and use nouns indicating the correct gender
- Able to identify and use nouns that indicate 'number'
- Able to identify and use nouns used as a direct object of a verb
- Able to identify and use nouns used as an object of a preposition
- Able to identify and use nouns used as appositives within a sentence
- Able to identify, and set off correctly, a noun used in direct address

**PRONOUNS**

- Able to identify and use personal pronouns correctly
- Able to identify correct agreement in number and gender between personal pronouns and their antecedents
- Able to identify and use pronouns as subjects
- Able to identify and use pronouns as objects
- Able to distinguish between possessive pronouns and contractions
- Able to identify and use pronouns correctly in a question
- Able to distinguish between the use of who and whom within a sentence
- Able to use correct pronouns in a sentence to express negation

**ADJECTIVES**

- Able to distinguish between proper and common adjectives by capitalizing proper adjectives
- Able to use adjectives before nouns and following a linking verb in a sentence
- Able to identify and use articles as adjectives

- Able to recognize possessive adjectives within a sentence
- Able to identify and use adjectives in different degrees of comparison
- Able to form the comparative and superlative forms of an adjective
- Able to spell adjectives correctly when changing into different degrees of comparison

**VERBS**
