It is staffed by qualified, experienced teachers holding degrees in Elementary Education and specializing in Early Childhood Education. The class ratio considers the requirements set by the Department of Education.

Our curriculum allows the preschool age child to explore, investigate, observe, participate, sing, laugh, play, pray, learn and grow physically, cognitively, emotionally, and spiritually. It incorporates perception ...memory...rhymes...alphabet & numbers...listening... problem solving... control ...self esteem...creativity... cooperation.
