

MIDDLE SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST

GRADES 6-8

To help with subject organization, consider buying the same colored notebooks/ binders/ book covers for each subject. This will help with a well-organized year!

- 1 inch binder for all middle school **Math** (plus 2 lined composition books for **8th grade students only**)
- 1 inch binder for **Science**
- 1 inch binder for **Social Studies**
- 1 ½ inch binder for **Language Arts**
- Binder paper for each (2 packs per binder is a good start – reinforced is best)
- Dividers with pockets for each binder (10 dividers total)

Notebooks that have plastic covers which are more durable are recommended.

- 5- subject notebook with pocket folders/dividers included for **religion**
- Rosary that can stay with you at school
- 1 notebook with pockets for **Spanish (or a notebook with a folder)**
- 1 notebook with pockets for **Health (or a notebook with a folder)**
- 1 folder for **music & computer**
- Ear buds
- A flash drive
- Pencils & pencil case (**without a permanent desk pencils are easily lost**)
- Pens – (red, blue/black)
- Package of dry erase markers
- 2 small containers rubber cement (Science)
- highlighters
- tissues
- hand sanitizer
- a container disinfectant wipes
- ream of computer paper

For **Art class**, bring the following in a large *durable* Ziploc **freezer** bag with your name (note that more items are listed this year for personal use vs. classroom sharing):

- 2 large glue sticks
- Small bottle of glue
- Colored pencils
- Crayons (24 pack)
- Scissors
- Fine black sharpie marker
- Extra fine black sharpie marker
- 2 Erasers
- Pocket folder & notebook
