## POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

Homeschool students can get involved in Queen of Angels School in a variety of ways, including taking classes on the campus and/or participating in extra-curricular activities. The following policies and procedures apply to homeschool students who choose to get involved at Queen of Angels Catholic School:

1. Before scheduling is determined, each family must meet with the principal.
2. A non-refundable Registration Fee of $\$ 25.00$ is required.
3. School standards for attendance, tardiness, and discipline apply.
4. Participation in field studies and other special events are tied to specific courses.
5. Fees are paid in full in advance or by the first day of each semester. Fees are nonrefundable after the semester has begun.
6. Specific course schedules may be obtained from the school office
7. Typically, regular class periods last 40 minutes and occur every day over the entire year.
8. Typically, extra-curricular classes last 40 minutes and occur once a week over the entire year.
9. The student must provide standard supplies.
10. Student dress code:

- Boys: navy blue or khaki slacks (no jeans) and red or blue polo shirt with school logo (ask about community room)
- Girls: navy blue or plaid skirt or navy or khaki slacks (no jeans) and a red or blue polo shirt with school logo (ask about community room)
- Boys and girls at all levels may wear blue or red sweaters (cardigan or V neck pullover).
- If a student is registered for a physical education class a gym uniform will need to be purchased.
