Afternoon Enrichment Option Available for children ages 3-5 11:30-2:30

Toddler Two Program

Classes meet once or twice a week

Our afternoon enrichment option provides students with a full day of learning as an extension of their core morning curriculum. The goal of enrichment is to provide a challenging curriculum through developmentally appropriate practices and to reinforce our students' readiness skills. Children will immerse themselves into a theme-based curriculum that is focused on preparing them for academic success.

Language and Reading – We will reinforce and develop literacy skills to become emergent

readers and writers. Students will continue to build on their alphabet knowledge and be introduced to sight words.

Math – Our goal in math is to construct a mathematical

understanding of the relationship between number and quantity. We will reinforce recognizing written numbers and become familiar with graphs and charts. Our Toddler Two program provides fun learning experiences that encourage your student to explore their environment and interact with their peers and teachers. This program is designed to meet the child's developmental needs by providing age-appropriate, adult-assisted play activities. Children must be two years old by October 1 and an adult must accompany a child to the class.



Children will practice self-help skills, motor skills, and socialization through:

- Discovery Centers
- Group Circle Time
- Singing
- Art Projects
- Creative Play

3-Year-Old Programs

2 days a week full or half day option Tuesday and Thursday


Our 3-year-old program offers an introduction to a classroom setting with a focus on social skills, self-help skills, and motor control skills with exposure to developmental and age-appropriate curriculum.

The Preschool Curriculum Includes:

• Language expression and listening skills cultivated through

circle time, literature, and music.

- Science, art, and dramatic play centers that allow children to explore, create, and discover.
- Fine and gross motor skills developed through art, educational manipulatives, and physical education classes.
- Faith-based education through bible stories and daily prayer.
- Various holidays and feast days that are celebrated together.

4-Year-Old Programs

3 days a week full or half day option (MWF) 5 days a week full or half day option

Our Prekindergarten program focuses on Kindergarten readiness and social/emotional skills that will help your child to succeed. This developmentally-appropriate curriculum provides opportunities for learning through a multi-sensory approach.

The Prekindergarten Curriculum Includes:

- Development of foundational literacy skills that emphasize phonemic awareness and alphabet knowledge in preparation for reading readiness.
- Mathematical skills taught through hands-on games and activities that deepen your student's understanding of numbers, geometry, and critical thinking.
- Fine motor skills enhanced through art, journaling, and building in the classroom, as well as during weekly art and STREAM classes. Gross motor skills developed during outdoor recess time and weekly physical education.
