


## **Uniform Policy & Uniform Room**

# **Dress Down Day Program**





#### Diocesan Clearances and Trainings

The Diocese of Greensburg requires all, school employees and all volunteers to have all of the following clearances and trainings prior to work or ministry in the diocese.+

- Diocesan Code of Pastoral Conduct PA Mandated Reporter Training VIRTUS Training Every Five Years
- PA Criminal History Check Form Every Five Years
- PA Child Abuse Form Every Five Years
  FBI Fingerprint Check Every Five Years. Initial submission must be done through screening agency. Then every five years screening agency submission OR an Affidavit for volunteers only ‡.
- ACT 24 Clearance

‡ CYO Coaches MUST obtain FBI Fingerprint Clearance every five years. They cannot submit a Volunteer Affidavit.

#### Additional Clearances for Catholic Schools Coaches

In addition to the Diocesan Clearances listed above, employees and volunteers working in our Catholic schools are required to also have the following clearances, based on Position.
