Re-Enrollment is Open!



Re-Enrollment for the 2026–2027 School Year

Re-enrollment for the **2026–27 school year** is now open. We encourage families to complete reenrollment **as soon as possible** to secure their child(ren)'s place for next year.

Please review the information below to complete the process.

Getting Started

- You should have received an email from FACTS with your **personalized re-enrollment link**.
- The email was sent to the address associated with your FACTS Financial Aid account.
- Click the link to begin reenrollment.

FACTS Account

- You will be prompted to **create a new FACTS reenrollment account**.
- This account is **separate from your Financial Aid account**.
- Much of your information will already be **prepopulated**.

Re-Enrollment Steps

- Begin by enrolling **Student #1**.
- Select a **tuition payment plan** (this is a preliminary selection).
 - If unsure, please choose **monthly**.

- After enrolling Student #1, you may proceed to **re-enroll additional students**.

Re-Enrollment Fee

- A **\$175 re-enrollment fee per family** is required.
- This fee:
 - Reserves your spot at the school
 - Covers FACTS platform costs
 - Includes **Financial Aid application and tuition agreement fees** that families may have paid separately in the past
 - *(Credit card processing fees are not included)*
- If you are prompted to submit the \$175 fee more than once, **do not pay again**—please contact the school.

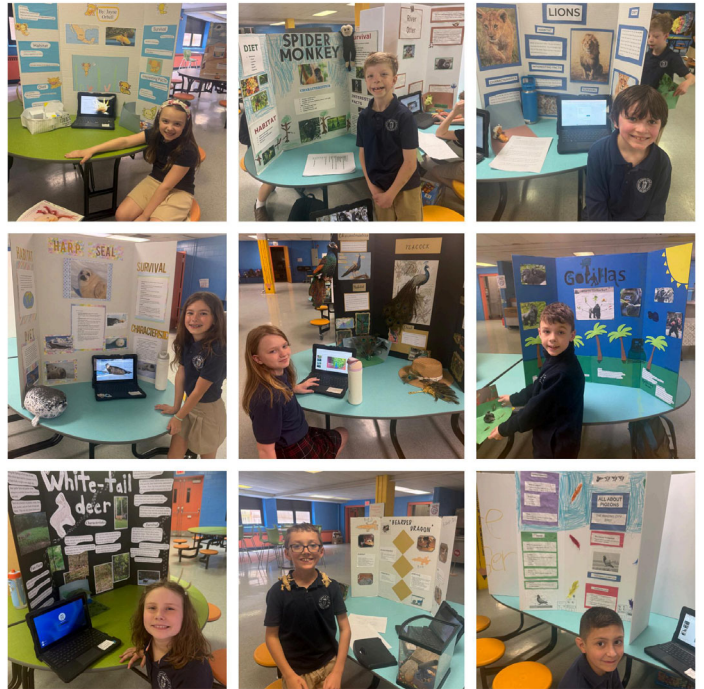

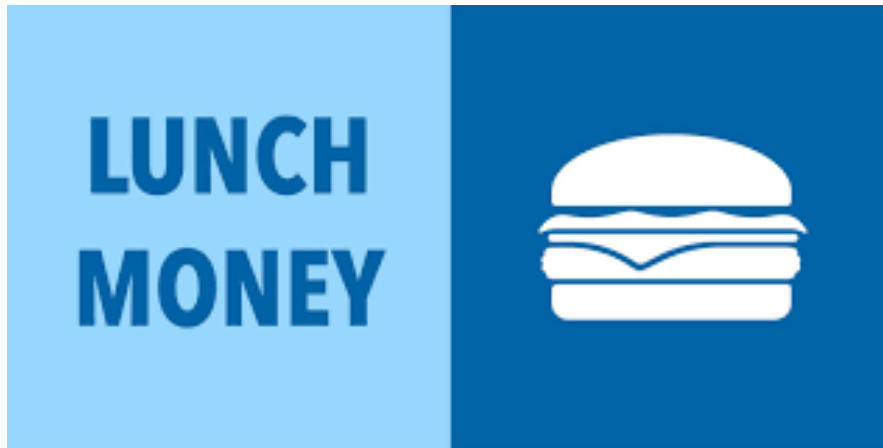

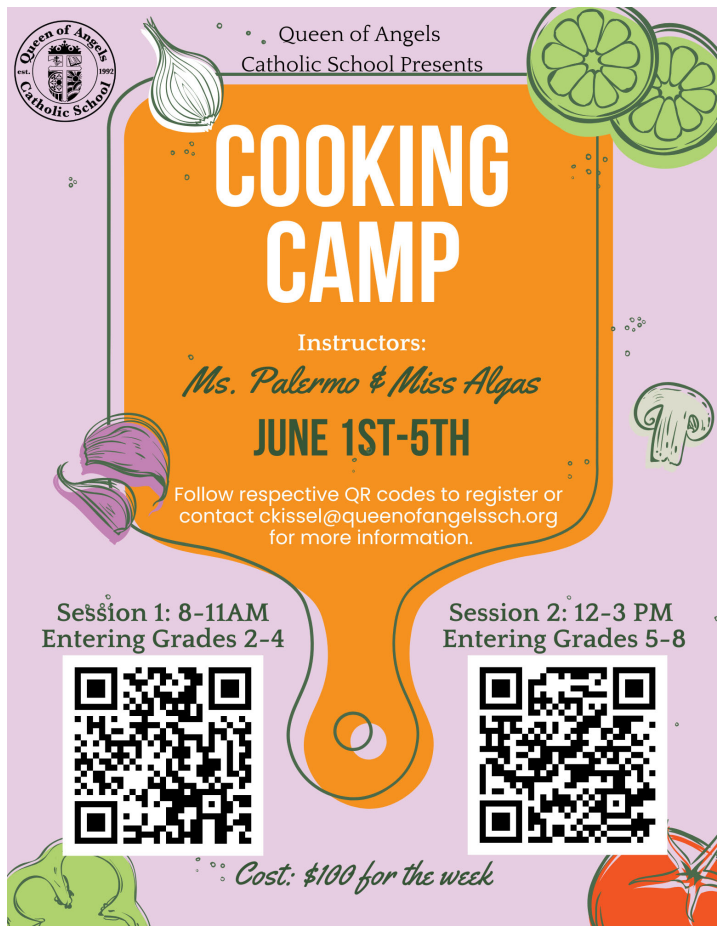

Let's make a difference together

IT **BEGINS** WITH **YOUR** PARTICIPATION

The taxpayer may select the Catholic School(s) in the Diocese of Greensburg to which they would like to make a contribution, in exchange for PA State Tax Credits.

- Minimum contribution

\$1,000

- Individuals must earn enough in state taxable income to participate.
- Business or individual taxpayers receive credits against Pennsylvania State Taxes for **90%** of that amount each year for a two-year commitment.

- The school will receive **Up to 100%** of the donor's contribution for tuition assistance in the next school year.

EXAMPLE:

*The Smith family contributed \$10,000 through the EITC program, as part of a two year commitment, and receives \$9,000 in state tax credits for that fiscal year. The remaining \$1,000 may be claimed as a charitable contribution. **Consult your Tax Professional for professional advice.***

HOW ARE TAXPAYER CONTRIBUTIONS USED?

The Diocese of Greensburg utilizes EITC for **tuition assistance** for students in **grades K-12**. Receiving families must meet financial requirements.

HOW IS FINANCIAL NEED DETERMINED?

Each of the Catholic Schools in the Diocese of Greensburg uses a **third party tuition management** system to evaluate and determine the financial needs of individual families.

CAN A TAXPAYER DESIGNATE A SPECIFIC SCHOOL TO RECEIVE ITS CONTRIBUTION?

Taxpayers may **designate their contribution** to the school of their choice or to the Diocese of Greensburg who will then **allocate their contribution** between two or more schools within the Catholic Schools in the Diocese of Greensburg.



The Diocese of Greensburg requires all, school employees and all volunteers to have all of the following clearances and trainings prior to work or ministry in the diocese.



- [PA Criminal History Check Form](#) - Every Five Years
- [PA Child Abuse Form](#) - Every Five Years
- [FBI Fingerprint Check](#) - Every Five Years. Initial submission must be done through screening agency. Then every five years screening agency submission OR an [Affidavit for volunteers only](#) ‡.
- [PA Mandated Reporter Training](#)
- [VIRTUS Training](#) - Every Five Years
- [Diocesan Code of Pastoral Conduct](#)
- [ACT 24 Clearance](#)

‡ CYO Coaches MUST obtain FBI Fingerprint Clearance every five years. They cannot submit a Volunteer Affidavit.

Additional Clearances for Catholic Schools Coaches

In addition to the Diocesan Clearances listed above, employees and volunteers working in our Catholic schools are required to also have the following clearances, based on Position.
